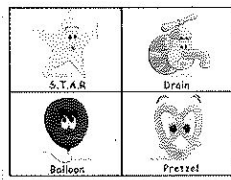


## **Preschool Distance Learning Day**

The following activities can be done throughout the day. These activities follow our curriculum we will be doing throughout the week. ### **Starting your day:**

- Music and Movement Activity. Ask your child to pick their favorite music and movement song.
- Breathing: Take 3 deep breaths to get our brains and bodies ready for learning. Pick one.



- Connection with an ***I Love You Ritual***. Ask your child what their favorite one is. If you are unfamiliar with some, here is the link about I Love You Rituals and why they are so important.: <https://youtube/C3PtrlnUm4U> . Some favorite I Love You Rituals are: *Twinkle Twinkle Little Star*, *Round and Round the Garden and Three Nice Mice*, and *Humpty Dumpty*.
- Wish Well. Who would you like to wish well today? Sing the Wish Well song with your child.

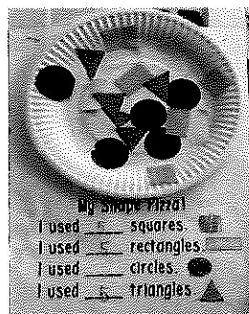

Sing The More We Get Together with your child.

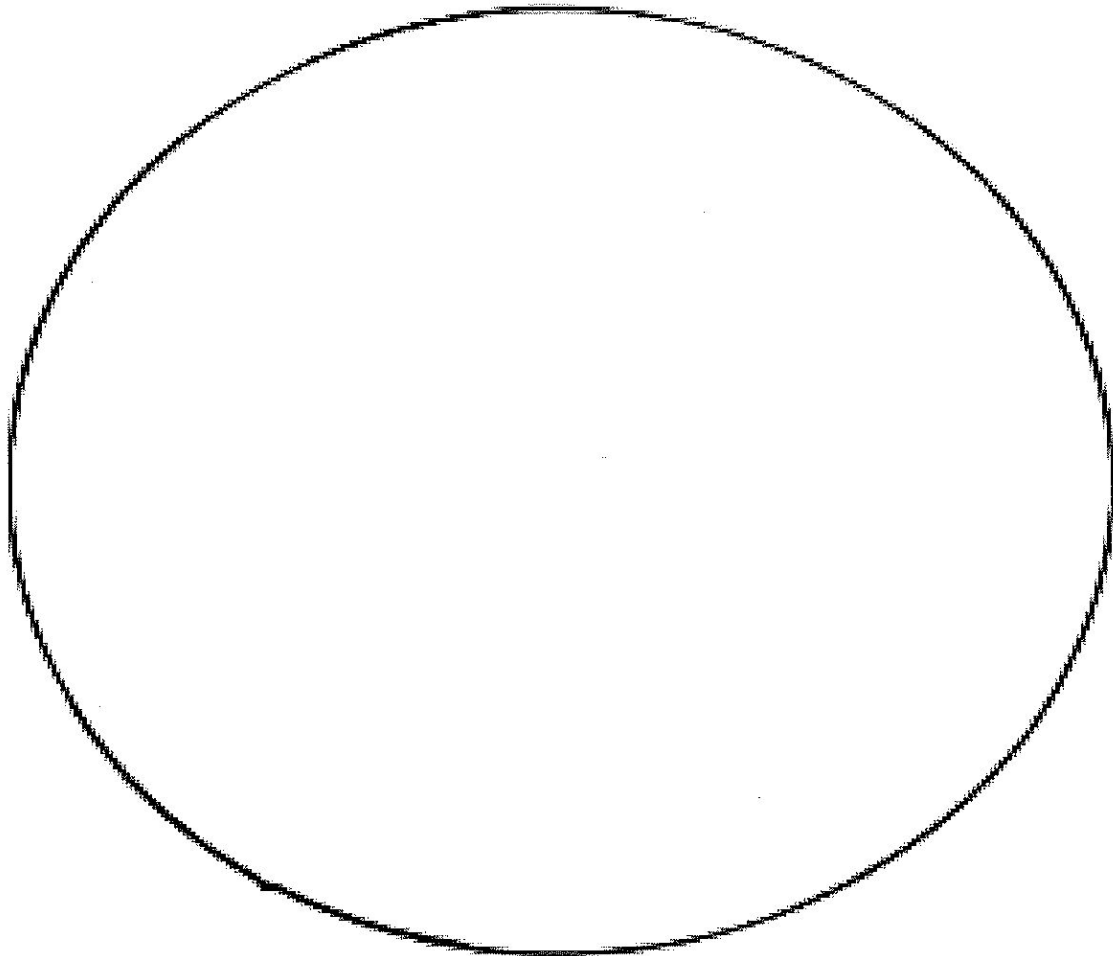
